#### **1. GOAL OF DISCIPLINE MASTERING**

The discipline "Russian as a Foreign Language" is included in the bachelor's program "Data Engineering and Space Systems Control" in the direction of 27.03.04 "Control in Technical Systems" and is studied in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th semesters of the 1st and 2nd courses. The discipline is implemented by the Department of Russian Language 4. The discipline consists of 1 section and 8 topics and is aimed at studying the Russian language at basic and elementary levels.

The goal of mastering the discipline is to master communicative and socio-cultural competencies with a minimum level of proficiency in the Russian language.
