1. OBJECTIVE OF THE DISCIPLINE

The discipline "Intercultural communication" is designed to interrogate the theories and concepts of intercultural communication, to analyze the impact of cross-cultural differences on process of interpretation in multicultural context. It focuses on the main theoretical aspects of intercultural communication, its basic concepts, terminology, and current research.

The main objectives are:

- to present the main concepts and research;
- to develop a better understanding of intercultural communication process;
- to form the skills and abilities of intercultural communication;
- to identify strategies of effective intercultural communication.
