## 1. COURSE GOAL(s)

The discipline “Russian as a Foreign Language” is included in the specialty program “Dentistry” in the direction of 31.05.03 “Dentistry” and is studied in semesters 1 and 2 1course. The discipline is implemented by the Department of Russian Language 5. The discipline consists of 3 sections and 9 topics and is aimed at studying educational and professional communication in Russian language.

The goal of the course is to develop and improve professional and communicative competence of foreign students, including as the main components linguistic, subject, sociocultural, strategic, compensatory, discursive, speech-behavioral, info communication and other competencies, which ensures the effectiveness of educational and professional communication in Russian, readiness and ability to solve professional communicative tasks using the target language.
