1. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME GOAL (MISSION)

The goal of the “MA in Political Science, Political Institutions and Values” educational programme is to train specialists in the field of political science. The training is aimed at researching and clarifying the specifics and essence of modern political processes occurring in the world, in line with institutional and civilizational approaches.

The educational programme is aimed at developing the knowledge, skills, abilities, and competencies in political science students in accordance with the requirements of the RUDN University OS in the field of study 41.04.04 Political Science.

2. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME RELEVANCE, SPECIFICITY, AND UNIQUENESS

Today, political science students following the programmes taught in the Russian language learn only about the Russian approach. Meanwhile, the English-taught programmes solely rely on English literature, leaving the Russian context aside. This programme is designed to overcome existing limitations.

The programme focuses primarily on the training of foreign students who do not speak Russian.

3. LABOUR MARKET NEEDS FOR PERSONNEL TRAINING IN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME PROFILE

Graduates of the “MA in Political Science, Political Institutions and Values” educational programme work in state and municipal government bodies in Russia and foreign countries, socio-political organizations, commercial and non-profit structures, academic and scientific research organizations, international departments of government agencies, leading world and Russian media, research and analytical centers, consulting structures (thinktanks), and business corporations whose activities affect the specifics of political science.

The need for graduates of the MA in Political Science, Political Institutions and Values programme may be due to the deepening value-political split in world politics, discursive confrontation, and the need to overcome axiological differences in promising foreign policy and public diplomacy.

4. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR POTENTIAL APPLICANTS

The applicant must possess a Bachelor's or Master's degree diploma certificate (or equivalent) issued at state institutions in Russia or abroad in the field of Humanities and Social Sciences (History, Philosophy, Sociology, International Relations, Economics, Law, Public Administration).

Documented knowledge of English at a level of at least B2 is required.

Additional requirements for applicants are determined by the Rules for the Admission of Citizens to the Federal State Educational Autonomous Institution of Higher Education "Peoples' Friendship University of Russia".

5. FEATURES OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION

5.1. The programme is implemented with the elements of e-learning/distance educational technologies (conducting lectures and seminars in a remote format, if necessary, using a telecommunication educational information system, etc.).

5.2. The programme is taught in English.

5.3. The programme is adapted for training of disabled persons and people with limited health capabilities.

5.4. The programme is implemented by the Federal State Autonomous Educational Institution of Higher Education "Russian Peoples' Friendship University named after Patrice Lumumba".
