## 1. COURSE GOAL(S)

The discipline “Exchange Trade” is part of the Master's program “International Trade” in the direction 38.04.01 “Economics” and is studied in the 3rd semester of the 2nd year. The discipline is realized by the Department of International Economic Relations. The discipline consists of 4 sections and 9 topics and is aimed at studying the basics and mechanisms of functioning of the Russian and world exchange trade.

The purpose of mastering the discipline is to form students' knowledge in the field of organization of exchange trading, technologies of conducting operations with financial instruments on the exchange.
