DESCRIPTION OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

1. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME GOAL (MISSION)

The main goal of the Higher Educational Programme is to train lawyers, highly qualified specialists, both for the Russian Federation and other countries as well as for international organizations.

The Higher Educational Programme aims to develop students' personal qualities and forming generic, general professional competences (according to the Educational Standard of RUDN University) and professional competences established for the “Bachelor of Laws” (LLB) training profile.

The Higher Educational Programme contributes to developing fundamental legal knowledge and applied skills in the field of Russian law, as well as the major Western and Eastern legal traditions (Great Britain, Germany, France, USA, China, countries of the Arab World, etc.) and international legal regulation.

The comparative legal approach allows students to obtain relevant knowledge and skills for professional legal practice in various jurisdictions.

2. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME RELEVANCE, SPECIFICITY, AND UNIQUENESS

Profile Orientation.

The preparation of undergraduate students is focused on forming deep theoretical knowledge in the field of jurisprudence and preparing them to solve professional problems at a high level of proficiency.

The use of modules in the educational process and combining disciplines into blocks allows students to form a systematic understanding of the relationship between institutions and branches of law, as well as analyze their interaction with foreign legal systems.

Using the comparative legal method in teaching law to students, their acquisition of the skills used to compare legal norms, institutions, principles, law enforcement practice, and other elements of legal cultures, allows the undergraduates to form a comprehensive vision of modern law.

Being taught in English allows them to study legal phenomena in the original language and helps students acquire the skills of legal argumentation and teaches them to draft legal documents in a foreign language.

The Higher Education Programme venue is RUDN University (Peoples' Friendship University of Russia) Law Institute (Russia, Moscow).
