1. COURSE GOALS

The purpose of studying the discipline "Economics of interstate territorial disputes" is to form students' understanding of the causes of the current interstate territorial disputes in the context of their geopolitical and economic prerequisites and consequences, as well as potential locations of future disputed territories on the world map. Ideas are given about the legal foundations for the formation of a state territory, the practice of securing and maintaining their territorial integrity by states, the concept of inviolability of borders, mechanisms and possible ways to solve certain territorial problems are considered.
