1. COURSE GOAL(s)

The discipline "Russian language for foreign students" is included in the program specialty "Dentistry" in the direction of 05.31.03 "Dentistry" and is studied in 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 semesters 1, 2, 3, 4 courses. The discipline is implemented by the Department of Russian Language 5. The discipline consists of 2 sections and 7 topics and is aimed at studying educational andprofessional communication in Russian.
