1. COURSE GOAL:

The aim of the course is working out the use of prepositional and case forms in a situation of natural speech communication and the formation of students' competencies related to oral and written communication in Russian.

Goals:

- teaching the meanings of cases using innovative techniques according to the author's methodology;
- prevention of errors related to the mixing of case values;
- consolidation of the skills of using prepositional and case forms in the conditions of natural communication;
- improving the skills of oral and written speech in accordance with its grammatical norms.
