## 1. THE GOAL OF MASTERING THE DISCIPLINE

The course "Russian as a Foreign Language" is included in the Master's program "General Agronomy" in the direction 35.04.04 "Agronomy" and is studied in semesters 1, 2, 3 1, 2 years. The discipline is implemented by the Department of Russian Language 5. The discipline consists of 4 sections and 14 topics and is aimed at studying the necessary theoretical and operational-practical basis for solving problems in the field of educational and professional communication by means of the Russian language.

The purpose of mastering the discipline is to develop and improve the professional and communicative competence of foreign students, which includes linguistic, subject, socio-cultural, strategic, as the main components, compensatory, discursive, speech behavioral, infocommunication and other competencies, which ensures the effectiveness of educational and professional communication in Russian, readiness and ability to solve professional and communication problems by means of the studied language.
