1. COURSE GOAL (s)

The course "Latin Language" is included in the speciality programme "Dentistry" majoring in 31.05.03 "Dentistry" and is studied in the first semester of the first year. The course is implemented by the Department of Foreign Languages. The discipline consists of 3 modules and 18 topics and is aimed at studying the rules of reading, elements of Latin grammar and methods of word formation, as well as medical terms of Greek-Latin origin.

The goal of the course is to provide the basis of the terminological competence of medical specialists who can use medical terminology of Greek-Latin origin consciously and competently in their practical and scientific activities, both in Latin and Russian languages.
